Applying for Tuition Assistance

The application process for the Neumann Scholarship and all forms of tuition assistance are now open. All applications for tuition assistance must be completed via the FACTs Grant and Aid Application which can be found online at <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>.

You will be asked to send the following documentation to complete the application process:

- Copies of your most recent Federal tax forms including all supporting tax schedules
- Copies of your most recent W-2 forms for both you and your spouse
- Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Child Support, Food stamps, Workers' Compensation and TANF.
(if you file a tax return but do not have W-2 wages because you are self-employed, you will be required to submit a copy of your current year Federal Form 1040 Tax Return)

You need only to fill out one form for tuition assistance. The FACTS Grant and Aid Application will qualify you for Neumann, EITC, OSTC, and parish assistance.

A nonrefundable application fee of \$35 will be required before your application will be submitted.

THE FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment must be complete and submitted by March 1, 2021.

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Income Eligibility Guideline:

Parents/Guardians maximum combined income: **\$92,160**. Income limit increases **\$16,222** for each additional dependent in the household. If any other member of the household files a Pennsylvania tax form, that income must be included in your calculation of household income.

For example, parents' combined taxable earnings are \$65,000. There are two dependent children in the household. One is a high school student with a part time job, who earned \$5,000. Household income is actually \$70,000. However, the family's income limit for eligibility is \$124,604 (\$92,160 + \$16,222 for each child). The family would meet the state eligibility guideline for a scholarship.

May I apply for more than one EITC scholarship?

Yes. There may be more than one organization offering partial scholarships in your area. The total amount of scholarship assistance you receive through the EITC program may not exceed the tuition that your family is responsible for.

Important Reminders

1. If you determine that you may be eligible for a scholarship, applications are available on-line.
2. One application is used per family, even if students attend different Catholic schools in the diocese.
3. Please fill in all forms carefully and attach the required documents. Federal tax forms may be required. If a family is not required to file a federal tax form with the IRS they may fill in a standard 1040 form and sign it, scan it for the application with FACTS, but not mail it to the IRS.
4. Applications are entered to FACTS by on-line application only.
5. Fee must be included with the application, unless the local school provides otherwise.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE ENTERED ON-LINE BY March 1, 2021.
